## About the Project

This project is part of a larger project to carry Class A Reclaimed Water from the LOTT Budd Inlet Reclaimed Water Plant to portions of Tumwater and Olympia. It involves installation of a new reclaimed water pipeline along Capitol Boulevard from Tumwater Falls Park to a short-term end point in the Tumwater Valley Municipal Golf Course. Hos Brothers of Woodinville, Washington, is the contractor for the project.

**Night work on Tumwater Valley Drive will resume the week of April 26.**

## Construction Update

Pipeline installation has been completed for the entire project. Remaining work includes the restoration of Tumwater Valley Drive and the paving at the intersection of E Street and Capitol Boulevard. Night work is scheduled to resume along Tumwater Valley Drive on Monday, April 26. This work will be followed by the paving at E Street and the reopening of the right-hand turn lane onto Capitol Boulevard. Every effort will be made to complete the paving of the roadways by May 1. However, paving activities are dependent in large part on the weather. Road grading, preparation, and paving will occur between 8 pm and 6 am. Expect noise and bright lighting in the immediate area during night work. In daylight hours, traffic on Tumwater Valley Drive will be impacted by intermittent lane closures and uneven surfaces.

## Project Coordination

The City of Tumwater is working with LOTT to pave the southbound lane of Tumwater Valley Drive and improve the condition of the overall roadway. Because this work was a late addition to the project, it has extended the project duration. The project is scheduled for completion by mid-May. Every effort will be made to minimize the duration of these construction impacts.

## Project Funding

The bulk of this project is funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act in cooperation with the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Washington State Department of Ecology. The City of Tumwater is providing funding for the additional paving of Tumwater Valley Drive.
